behavior	actions of a person
case management	a way to organize nursing care for a resident that involves continuous assessment and evaluations in order to maintain the highest level of functioning for a resident
confidentiality	trust that someone will not share private information about you with someone else
cooperative	working together
dependable	able to be trusted to do what is expected or needed
ethical	agreeing with accepted standards of professional conduct and behavior
ethics	standards of conduct or moral judgment
HIPPA	law protecting confidentiality of residents
legal	allowed to do something by law
professional	someone who works in a job that needs special education or training
purpose	the reason that explains why something is needed
rehabilitation	helping a person who is physically or mentally disabled to return to a more normal life
responsible	1. able to make good judgments 2. having the job of being in charge of something
staff	group of people who work together under a supervisor
task	work that needs to be done
teamwork	combined effort of people working together
volunteer	person who offers to help and does not get paid money
