

## Unit 2 Lesson 2 Kinds of Beds



A **closed bed** means that it is not in use until the resident bedtime. It is also a bed that is ready for a new resident. Notice that the top linens are NOT folded back.

An open bed is in use. It's ready for the resident to get into. The covers are fanfolded so that the person can get into bed and easily pull the covers up. The open bed in the picture also has a drawsheet in the center of the bed.



An **occupied bed** has a person in the bed. The bed is made while the person is in the bed.
