| 6. cyanotic | blue coloring seen in nails, lips, and skin because of lack of oxygen |
| 7. danger | chance of harm, exposure to injury or lose of life |
| 8. defective | imperfect, faulty |
| 9. difficult | not easy; hard to understand or do |
| 10. disaster | sudden event (such as a storm) that causes great damage |
| 11. exit | way to leave a building or room |
| 12. fire | burning with flames, heat, light |

| 22. OSHA | Occupational Safety and Health Administration is the federal agency that protects the safety of workers |
| 23. oxygen tank | green tank (small portable or large tank) filled with oxygen to be used with mask or hose |
| 24. R.A.C.E. | Rescue - Alarm/alert - Contain fire - Extinguish or Evacuate |
| 25. risk factors | things that may cause injury or illness |
| 26. rubbish | waste material; trash; garbage |
| 27. safety | being safe, freedom from danger |
| 28. source | place where something comes from or begins |
| 29. sparks | tiny glow from a burning fire |
