Vocabulary	Definition
1. bath	water that you sit or lie in to wash yourself
2. bathtub	a large container in which you sit to wash yourself
3. bed bath	a thorough body wash given to someone who cannot leave their bed
4. brakes	part that keeps wheels from moving
5. draft	cold windy air from an open window or door
6. excessive	more than is necessary
7. exposure	the harmful effects on your body of being outside in very cold or heat or sun
8. extremity	part of the body that furthest away from the center; arms, fingers, legs, toes.
9. lift	a device to assist with moving a resident
10. mechanism	part of a machine that does a particular job
11. mitt	hand covering that does not have separate parts for each finger; made from wash cloth and used for bathing
12. partial bath	bathing the person's face, hands, underarms, back, buttocks, and perineal area
13. shower	a place where you can sit in a chair or bench or stand in to wash your whole body
14. slippery	something that is slippery is difficult to hold or walk on because it is wet or greasy
15. sponge	a piece of a soft natural or artificial substance full of small holes, which can suck up liquid and is used for washing
16. sufficient	as much as is needed; enough

17. suitable	have the correct purpose or use
18. temperature	a measure of how hot or cold a room, area, water, or liquid is
19. versatility	able to be used in a number of different ways
20. whirlpool	a large bathtub that makes hot water move in strong currents around your body
