Grooming

Vocabulary	Definition
1. abrasion	an area on the surface of your skin that has been injured by being rubbed against something hard
2. blister	a swelling on your skin containing clear liquid caused by a burn or continuous rubbing
3. brush	an object that you use for cleaning, painting, making your hair tidy
4. clippers	special tool used to cut nails neatly
5. comb	a flat piece of plastic, metal with a row of thin teeth on one side, used for making your hair tidy
6. crème rinse	solution applied to the hair after shampooing to make the hair soft and easy to comb; also called conditioner
7. facial	having to do with the face
8. file	small flat rough board used to remove rough edges of the nail
9. grooming	taking care of your appearance by keeping hair, clothes, and glasses clean and neat
10. itch	an uncomfortable feeling on your skin that makes you want to rub it with your nails
11. nails	your nails are the hard smooth layers on the ends of your fingers and toes
12. orange stick	wooden stick used to push back the cuticle area of the nail
13. precaution	something you do in order to prevent something dangerous or unpleasant from happening
14. rash	a lot of red spots on someone's skin, caused by an illness or allergy
15. razor	a tool with a sharp blade, used to remove hair from your skin
16. scalp	the skin on the top of your head

17. shampoo	a liquid soap for washing your hair
18. have	to have the hair removed from your face or body
19. tangle	a twisted mass of something such as hair
