Assisting Residents

Verb	Definition
1. alternate	if two things alternate, or if you alternate them, they happen one after the other in a repeated pattern
2. clear away	to move items off or away from an area. For example, clear away dishes from a table after eating
3. converse	to have a conversation with someone
4. deviate	to change the way something is normally done
5. document	to write about something, film it, or take photographs of it, in order to record information about it
6. drink	to take liquid into your mouth and swallow it
7. elevate	to lift someone or something to a higher position
8. feed	to give food to a person
9. prepare	to make a meal, make plans, or get something ready to use
10. press	to push something firmly against a surface
11. remind	to make someone remember something that they must do
12. serve	to give someone food or drink, especially as part of a meal
13. sip	to drink something slowly, taking very small mouthfuls
